

Show Us Ya Slotz

12 Hour Enduro Teams Event:

12 hour event across 12 lanes (2 Tracks) over 2 days

Date: 24th & 25th May 2025

Class: Flexi Sedan & Retro

Race Format:

Each Heat will be 1 Hour long per lane, and will run over 2 days. This is a team event, and it is recommended to be a minimum of a 3 person team. (1 marshalling, 1 racing, 1 taking a break).

The race will be a combination of 'Flexi Sedan' on the Flat Track, and Aussie Retro on the Suzuka Track.

The racing field will be split between the Retro and the Flexi Sedan classes on the Saturday, and then ran Vice Versa on the Sunday.

The Total Number of Combines Laps Determine the Finishing Positions.

Qualifying will be on Saturday Morning starting at 10am, with the Flexi Sedan Class on the Flat Track in a fixed chosen lane that will be revealed on the day over 1 minute. (1 entrant from each team to qualify).

Top Qualifier will have the choice of racing either the Flexi Sedan or the Retro on the Saturday, and of starting lane choice.

This is a 1 car event per team. Each team will be allowed 1 x 'Time Call' of 5 minutes per day for repairs / breakdowns, including motor replacement. (Additional motors to the handouts may be purchased).

Rules as per ASCRA website (<https://ascra.au/viewforum.php?f=56>) With any event specific changes as listed. Cars will be Teched again around halfway for clearance and width checks.

Motor: Each Team will receive 2 x Cheetah 4 Pre Run in Motors (marked Motors) One for each Class. With the Option to purchase additional 'marked' motors from the track at \$10 each. Motors will be checked at Scrutineering, and none marked motors will be excluded from racing. The motors may be notched for axle clearance, and may be screwed, glued or soldered in.

Gears: This will be fixed gearing event. Retro 9\26, Flexi 13/36. This is to assist non local racers to focus on car setup and dialling in to the track without having to compete against local gearing knowledge, and also to help prevent burning out motors.

Bearings: Flexi Sedan: Oilites only – May be soldered or glued to the chassis.
Retro: Refer ASCRA Link.

Wheels: Rear: Flexi Sedan Class: Max 0.765"
Rear: Retro Class: Must be a Minimum 0.800"
Front: Flexi Any 0.5" min dia. Mounted at original mounting points or wheel stickers.

Front: Retro: Ball Bearing permitted. Refer ACRRA Link

Tyres may be taped or cleaned with Shellite. No tyre "goo" traction additives permitted on tyres or the track.

Chassis: Sedan Class: JK C21 Chassis

Aussie Retro: Refer ASCRA Link.

Motor can be screwed or soldered in place. Motor and axle bracing permitted. Motor mounting tabs may not be removed. No aluminium parts.

Clearances: Aussie Retro: Refer ASCRA Link.

Flexi: Maximum width 85mm. Front clearance - Guide must be spaced to achieve front chassis clearance of .5mm. Rear clearance – 1mm.

Body: Minimum of 0.010" Lexan In both classes.

Flexi Sedan: Ralph Thorne Honda NSX Sedan

Body may be mounted with body clips or 'Fixed' Pin Tubes only.

Aussie Retro: Refer ASCRA Link.

Body may be mounted with fixed or floating Pin Tubes. (Also refer to ASCRA Rules)

Race Format:

Tracks will be available 10am to 4pm Thursday, and 10am to 8pm Friday for practice.

Scrutineering starts at (TBA)

Qualifying will be on Saturday Morning:

Entry Details: Doors Open Saturday at 8.00am, Racing Starts after Qualifying (Qualifying starts at 10am) & and will run to approx. 6pm

Sunday: Doors open 8am, Racing to commence at 9am to finish approx. 5pm

Cost \$30 per Person per Day: FOOD Truck onsite all Day to purchase your own food.

Accommodation

Limited space is available for caravans / camper trailers in the carpark area By Pre-Arrangement (Note: ground is gravel). Showers and Toilet will be made available in the evening after Racing, and Early in the morning prior to racing..
